SEPTEMBER 2010 - Coastal Clean Up Day Events!

23rd – Santa Paula Creek, 4-6 pm (Coastal Clean Up Day!)

Santa Paula Creek is littered with trash ranging from plastic bags to shopping carts. The trash and debris from the Santa Paula Creek, a major tributary to the Santa Clara River, not only impairs Southern California Steelhead habitat and the aesthetic integrity of the creek, but impairs the ecological integrity and water quality of Ventura County's coastal and marine waters.

(Directions: From the 101 freeway head East on the 126, Pass through Santa Paula over the Santa Paula Creek bridge, Make a left on Hallock Drive, make a left onto Telegraph Road and meet along the Santa Paula Creek bridge on Telegraph Road; (For Google directions: 17350 E. Telegraph Rd, Santa Paula, Ventura, CA).

24th – Ormond Beach Wetlands, 4-6 pm (Coastal Clean Up Day!)

The Ormond Beach Wetlands is home to, and serves as migratory grounds for, numerous federally listed endangered species including the snowy plover, California least tern, and tidewater goby. The wetlands are of significant importance to Oxnard's residents,

(Directions: From 101 freeway head west on Rice Road, make a Right on Hueneme, make a left of Perkins Road. Meet at the coastal / western most end of Perkins Rd, Oxnard CA, in the Ormond Beach Parking Lot).

24th - San Buenaventura State Beach, 4-6 pm (Coastal Clean Up Day!)

This beach features swimming, surfing and picnicking. The beach has two miles of sandy beach. Bike trails connect other nearby beaches. The beach is the site for a number of special events, such as the Pirate Festival, triathlon, and volleyball tournaments. A 1,700-foot pier has a snack bar, restaurant and bait shop.

(Directions: From the 101 Freeway, exit Seward and go West; make a Right on Pierpont; Make a Right on San Pedro St, Right into San Buenaventura State Beach, and follow signs for Trash Clean Up. (for Google directions type: 911 San Pedro St, Ventura, CA).
